
The member company name has to be the same for all chapter memberships. Only one member contact per chapter listing. All memberships share the same expiration date.

The \$480 advocacy support fee is the primary source of funds for CAI's legislative and regulatory efforts. All fees from members in states with an authorized CAI Legislative Action Committee (LAC) directly support the LACs' efforts to represent and protect members in those states. (There were 32 state LACs as of December 2009.)
